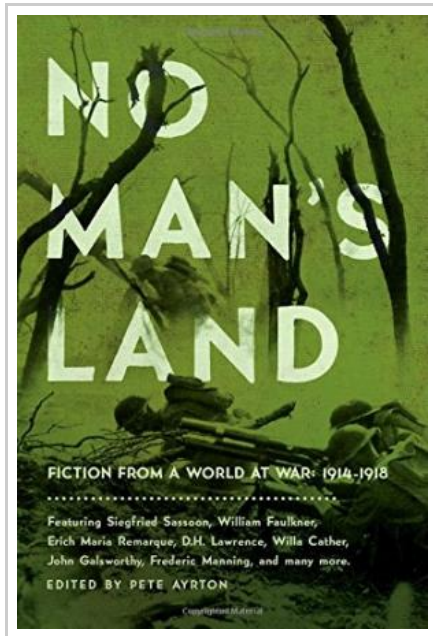




No Man's Land: Fiction from a World at War: 19141918
