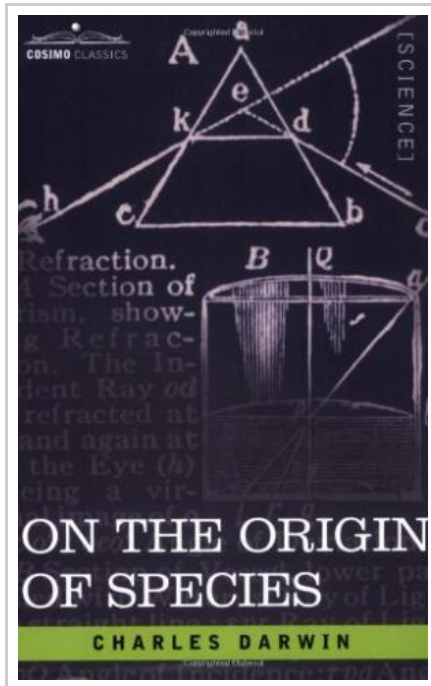




On the Origin of Species: By Means of Natural Selection or the Preservation of Favored Races in the Struggle for Life
