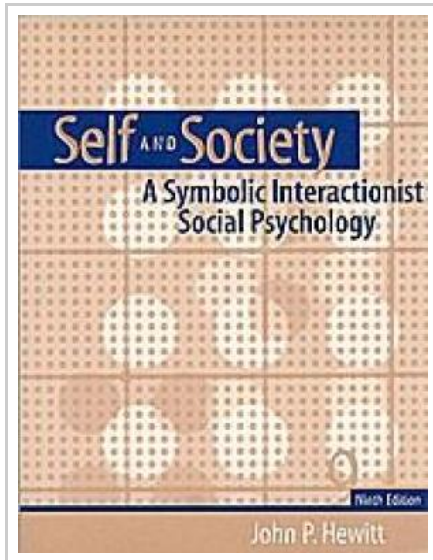




Self and Society
