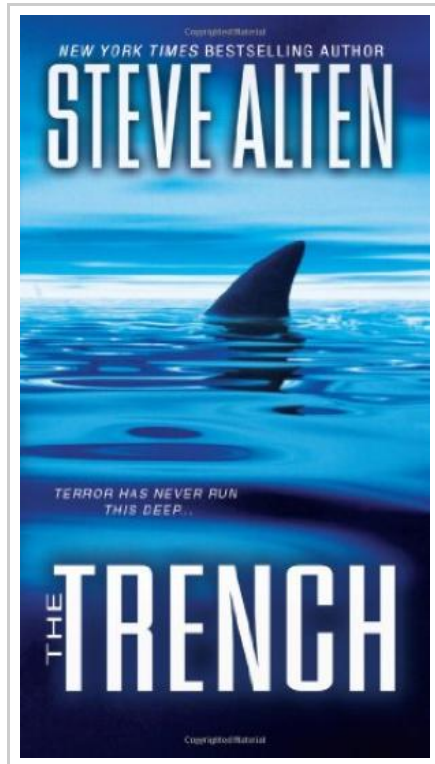




The Trench
