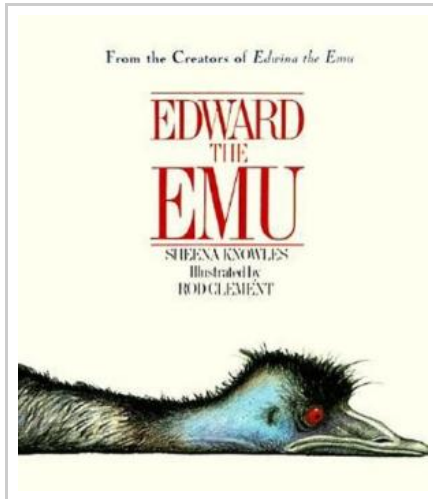




Edward the Emu (Hardback)
