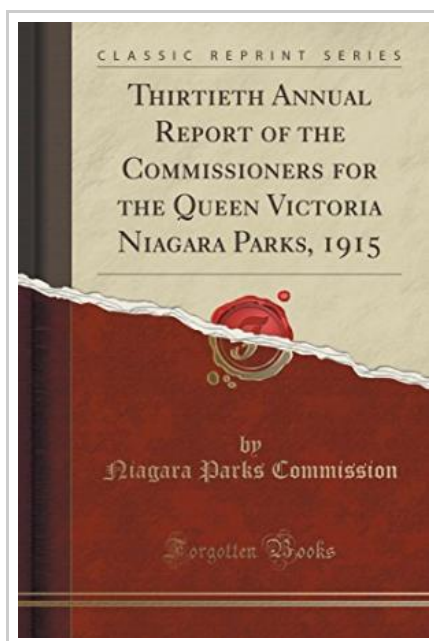

Before entering upon a resume of the operations comprising the maintenance and improvement of the Park System, it is only fitting that some extended reference should be made to the passing away of the Chairman of the Board, the late Mr. John Woodburn Langmuir, on May 12th. As far back as 1878 the national preservation of the Falls of Niagara and the adjacent territory had been suggested by Lord Dufferin, and on the New York side by Governor Robertson, but it was not until 1880 that any definite action was taken. In this year the Provincial Legislature of Ontario conferred upon the Dominion Government authority to carry out the project in so far as lands under the jurisdiction of the Ontario Government were...



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
