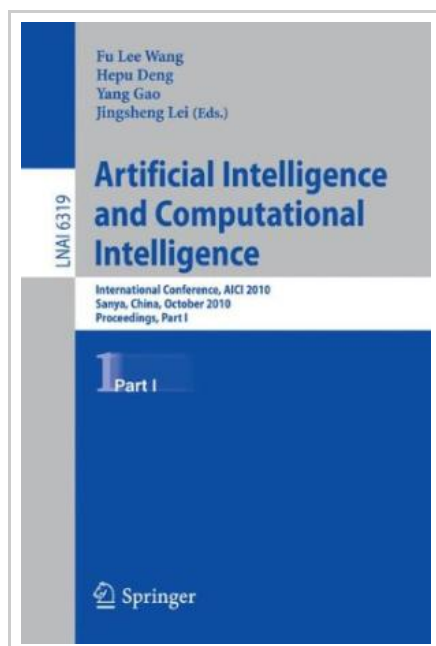




Artificial Intelligence and Computational Intelligence: Part I: International Conference, AICI 2010, Sanya, China, October 23-24, 2010, Proceedings
