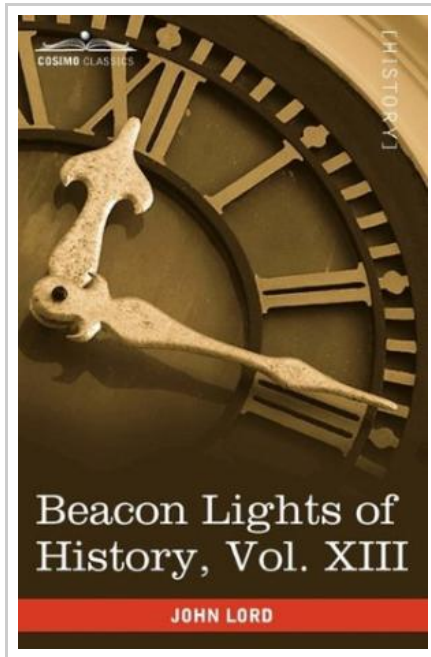




Beacon Lights of History, Vol. XIII: Great Writers (in 15 Volumes)

This replica edition features all the original illustrations, hard to come by in other recent versions. It will delight both readers of history and lovers of beautiful, classic books.
